### AHC 2010 Accomplishments

- AHC staff, volunteers and interns have planned and implemented over ( **14** ) community outreach, ( **1** ) seminars and ( **3** ) workshops around health and immigrant .
- Cumulatively we have directly reached over ( **200** ) people through workshops; Engaged ( **80** ) women a month and spending over ( **500** ) hours weekly through Umoja Sisterhood Support Group conference call.
- Through our outreach conducted by staff, volunteers and interns over ( **2500** ) people have received information on health and immigration this year.
- We have a network of more than ( **30** ) providers/ institutions around health, legal and social issues.
- Successfully launched Leadership Coaching for about ( **12** ) women and young girls.
- In 2010 we received an award from the US Census Bureau for community organizing activities encouraging the community to participate in the U.S Census 2010.
- Clarisse Mefotso Fall, Executive Director received BIA (Bureau of Immigration Affairs) Accreditation to provide in-house immigration assistance.

### AHC 2011 Initiatives

This is just a snippet of what we are planning for next year 2011, :

#### Rose Program (Rights, Organize, Social, Equality)

- Advocacy and community organizing campaigns on **“Repair your Status, Reclaim your Rights”**
- Build Legal Team comprised of interns, current collaborating lawyers, and legal network.
- Direct Assistance: Matching Process Fees: Donor AHC fundraise to match processing fees of clients.
- To bring together Service providers and stakeholders at the community Forum/Summit for the purpose of exchanging ideas and finding solutions.

#### Ngeumne HIV/AIDS Initiative

- Parent-Child Communication Workshop: To improve parent-child communication amongst African immigrant families
- Community-level interventions and mobilization.
- Men as Partners Transformation Agent Training Workshop
- Community Outreach: AHC will develop an outreach plan with specific Outreach venues to serve cluster communities.
